

# Weather information

Rishiri Island is located at a latitude of 45 degrees. Since this area experiences sudden and significant changes in temperature and weather, take a long-sleeved waterproof jacket or windbreaker when heading out.

April	14.5°c	-2.2℃	Snow continues to melt and in the middle of the month, early spring flowers start to bloom on the plains near the coast. Whatever the temperature, it sometimes snows.	
May	21.8℃	-0.3°c	There are some chilly days, and the weather is cool. Snow remains around the base of Mt. Rishiri. You can see early spring flowers on the coastal plains and forest floor. This is the optimal season for birdwatching. Mt. Rishiri opens for climbing from the middle of the month.	
June	24.3℃	3.8℃	Summer flowers, known as Ezokanzo, start to bloom, and Rishiri Island becomes even more attractive.  The sea urchin season starts from the middle of month.	
July	25.6℃	9.8℃	Rishiri Island becomes more lively.  The Rishiri kombu (kelp) season starts. On sunny calm days, you can see majestic views of fishing.	
August	31.20	12.9℃	Rishiri Island's short summer reaches its peak.  At the start of the month, there are multiday festivals.  The approach of autumn can be sensed from the middle of the month.	
September	27.7℃	7.0℃	Occasional periods of clear and calm weather. In the evening, you can see beautiful scenery stained gold by pampas grass on the flatlands. At the end of the month, the leaves of the trees start to change color. Salmon start to swim upstream.  The trail to Mt. Rishiri closes in the middle of the month.	
October	<b>20.4</b> ℃	-0.3c	In the cold mornings of early October, the first snow can be seen to crown Mt. Rishiri. In the forest, you start to see reddening leaves and hear the chirping of migratory birds. At the end of the month, snow starts to fall on the flatlands.	

## Sunrise and Sunset Time Information



Lighting facilities are not located along the trails. Check the sunset time before heading out and allow yourself enough time to return to your accommodation before it gets dark.

Hokkaido is located in the far east of its time zone, so the sunrise and sunset may be earlier than expected.
